



Bare Bones Go-Kits

What would you have in a bare-bones go-kit. A down to the nitty-gritty functional kit in your wife's purse.... OK maybe not your wife's purse...A bare-bones go-kit that has to fit inside a fancy "give-away" nylon/plastic cooler type bag; 8" wide, 5" deep and 6" tall and has a pouch across the front with no zipper. Something like you could find in your local grocery, Dollar Store or Wal-Mart...

HT fully charged, Rubber Duck Antenna, loaded battery tray, 12 extra batteries and operating instructions for the HT.

Roll-up 300 ohm twin lead J-pole antenna with 20' of RG8x plus coaxial adapters and 30' of fishing line with a ½" nut tied into the end of the fishing line.

Poncho, 4 tins of canned fish, crackers, snacks, plastic flatware, part of a roll of T-P, in a zip-lock bag band aides & small tube of 3 in 1 anti-biotic, some Tylenol, small bottle of Pepto-Bismol, pocket knife, small flashlight, one change of skivvies, socks and meds for 2 days.

A steno-pad and several pencils in the outside pouch

This should give an idea for a starting point for your own go-kit. Light yet functional enough to get you into the fray and stay comfortable at the same time.
